Initial requirements

- An overseas teacher qualification, and necessary equivalent qualifications (bachelors degree and GCSE English, Maths and Science qualifications, **as verified by UK NARIC**).
- Employment as an unqualified teacher in a school;
- Work permit (applicable if you are not a national of the European Economic Area).
- Teaching experience in at least two different schools and across two consecutive key stages.
- Minimum of 18 weeks teaching experience in a UK primary school before final assessment.
- A current enhanced CRB disclosure.
- Good physical and mental fitness to teach.
- Applicants should be aware they will need to pass online skills tests in numeracy, literacy and ICT before they can awarded QTS.

TMA ITT Partnership reserves the right not to accept individuals onto the programme if they do not meet the QTS standards set within the initial assessment. Advice will be given as to other possible routes to QTS.
